The celebration also aims to unite the entire JCA community together as proceeds of the shows and the booths will be donated to the 4th Street Building project.

1. Program in the Community Hall

- 1.1.9:00-10:00 AM - *The Fast and Curious* is a Math and Science variety show featuring exciting performances from the Pep Squad and Elementary students, guest performer, and exciting challenges that everyone can participate in.
- 1.2.10:30 AM - 12:00 NN - *S.O.A.R. Band Fest: Sing Out and Rejoice!*

2. Booth Rentals and Sponsorship

- 2.1. There will be food, games, and merchandise booth rental to students, parents, personnel, alumni, and individuals outside of JCA. Interested parties may inquire with the Administration Office at the E. Rodriguez campus campus from January 14, 2019 to January 25, 2019, 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm.
- 2.2. All booths will be opened from 7:30 am to 2:30 pm

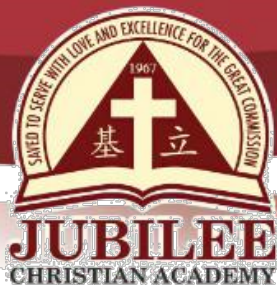
3. Fair Day Guidelines

- 3.1. Casual attire for students, parents and guests following JCA prescribed dress code.

3.2. Arrival

3.2.1. Parking

- 3.2.1.1. F. Manalo St. from Don Alfredo Egea St. to Judge Jimenez St. shall be closed to traffic and parking of vehicles of non-residents. Parties may enter and exit via F. Manila St. on foot.
- 3.2.1.2. Strictly no parking on F. Manalo St., D. Egea St., and E. Rodriguez Ave. at any time.
- 3.2.1.3. Be reminded not to leave valuables in your parked vehicles. The School and the Barangay shall not be responsible for any damage to or loss of parked vehicles.



3.2.2. Entrance

3.2.2.1. Students and guests may use either the E. Rodriguez or F. Manalo gate for entrance.

3.2.2.2. No entrance fees for JCA students provided they bring their JCA ID. Any student who fails to bring his / her ID will have to pay the P 75.00 entrance fee.

3.2.3. Parents / guardians / guests

3.2.3.1. Each Preschool to Grade 3 student must have one adult companion (e.g., parent, guardian, caregiver). One adult companion can enter for free.

3.2.3.2. All other parents / guardians / guests will have to pay P 75.00 entrance fee.

3.2.3.3. Except for the performers, everyone will pay P175.00 for *The Fast and Curious* and P225.00 for the *S.O.A.R. Band Fest: Sing Out and Rejoice!*

3.2.3.4. Entrance & program tickets can be purchased from E. Rodriguez Campus Bookstore, 7:00 am to 7:30 am and 12:30-1:30 pm, and D. Hemady Campus Bookstore, 7:30 am to 10:30 am, starting January 17, 2019, Monday to Friday.

4. Attendance Checking

4.1. Checking of attendance will be done in the second floor:

4.1.1. Grade 4 to 6 students—In front of JEChapel

4.1.2. Junior High School students—in front of Junior High School Office

4.1.3. Senior High School students—in front of the Senior High School Office

5. Cash Transactions

All transactions with food, game booths, and merchandise are in CASH. Please see to it that your children bring enough cash.

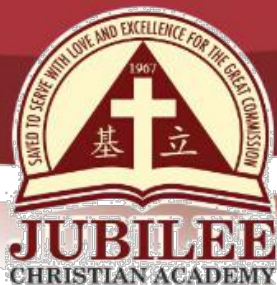
6. The Eagle Pass

6.3. Admission tickets for *The Fast and Curious: A Math and Science Variety Show* and *S.O.A.R. Band Fest: Sing Out and Rejoice!* are available for purchase individually.



7. Sponsorship

As part of our fundraising for the 4th Street Building, interested parties may participate via sponsorship.

- 7.1.To give maximum exposure, sponsor's standing tarpaulin with maximum size of 4 feet (H) x 2 feet (W) will be put up at the Community Hall where the two shows will be held.
- 7.2.Tarpaulin will have to be provided by the sponsor.
- 7.3.Sponsorship fee is at Php 5,000.00 per tarpaulin.

8. Reminders

- 8.1.Those who will attend are requested to bring their own small mat or pillow. Bleachers will be available at the Community Hall for those who have difficulty standing for a longer period of time.
- 8.2.Food and drinks, except bottled water, are not allowed inside the Community Hall to maintain cleanliness of the area. Observe proper waste segregation at all times, when eating in the hallways and canteen area.
- 8.3.In case of emergency, please use the stairway nearest to you and proceed to the nearest gate.

9. Dismissal Procedure

- 9.1.Preschool to Grade 3 students accompanied by their parents / guardians can leave anytime, but they can not re-enter the campus without buying entrance tickets.
- 9.2.To avoid overcrowding in the waiting area, dismissal time is as follows:
