SUBJECT : 52nd FOUNDATION DAY REMINDERS, EAGLE PASS, AND "SOARVIVAL MAP"

Come and celebrate with us at our 52nd Foundation Day Fair on Friday, February 1, 2019. Please take note of these reminders to enjoy the shows, booths, and other fun activities.

- 1. F. Manalo St. from Don Alfredo Egea St. to Judge Jimenez St. shall be closed to traffic and parking of vehicles of non-residents. Parties may enter and exit via F. Manila St. on foot. Strictly no parking on F. Manalo St., D. Egea St., and E. Rodriguez Ave. at any time. Be reminded not to leave valuables in your parked vehicles. The School and the Barangay shall not be responsible for any damage to or loss of parked vehicles.
- 2. No entrance fees for JCA students provided they bring their JCA ID. Any student who fails to bring their ID will have to pay Php 75.00 entrance fee. Entrance tickets can be purchased in F. Manalo and E. Rodriguez gates. Each Preschool to Grade 3 student must bring in one parent/ guardian for free. All other parents/ guardians/ guests will have to pay Php 75.00 entrance fee.
- 3. The only entrance to the Community Hall for the two shows, S.O.A.R. Band Fest: "Sing Out and Rejoice!" and The Fast and Curious will be the sliding doors located at the 3rd Floor. Doors will open at 8:30 am for the S.O.A.R. Band Fest and at 10:45 am for The Fast and Curious. Each show is separately ticketed.
- 4. The doors leading to the Badminton Court and Open Court are the only exit ways from the Community Hall.
- Food and drinks are not allowed inside the Community Hall to maintain cleanliness of the area. Observe proper waste segregation at all times, when eating in the hallways and canteen area.
- 6. Except for the bleachers, no chairs will be provided. Those who will attend are requested to bring their own small seating mat or pillow instead.
- 7. Come in your comfortable attire following JCA dress code.
- 8. Please follow the same fetching procedures for Grades 4 to 6. No Fetcher's Card, No Entry.
- 9. In case of emergency, please use the stairway nearest to you and proceed to the nearest gate.

There will be tokens and good surprises for those who will participate actively during the program.

EAGLE PASS (SILVER / GOLD)

Those who have availed the Eagle Pass (Silver / Gold) are reminded to bring their tickets. Pass must be presented at the show entrance and booths in order to avail of the show and games.

The Student Council Booth at the 4th Floor, adjacent the Badminton Court, and all Grade 11 Math-Science Food Booths are authorised Eagle Pass (Gold) food providers. Eagle Pass (Gold) holders will have to present the food stub to claim the food.
