Greetings! Please be informed of the following admission application updates for ADMU and UST.

<p>Ateneo De Manila University www.ateneo.edu.ph</p> <p>ACET is suspended for this admission cycle. For SY 2021-2022, admission will be based on the applicant's academic and non-academic performance in Grade 9, 10 and 11, the class rankings, the applicant's admission essay and on the recommendations.</p>	<p>University of Santo Tomas https://ustet.ust.edu.ph</p> <p>USTET will not be administered for the Academic Year 2020-2021 due to community quarantine restrictions. Applicants for admission will instead undergo through University of Santo Tomas Admission Rating (USTAR). The process generally includes the computation of a score based on the applicant's academic performance and records.</p>

This is the program that the applicant prefers to be admitted too. This is their primary interest in which they intend to further their knowledge and skills.* Alternative Program. In case the applicant does not meet the criteria of his/her priority program, they will be considered in this program subject to the criteria set by the College. Once an applicant qualifies in their priority program, the alternative program is no longer processed.Passing the USTAR is not the sole basis for admission to some Colleges. Some Colleges may require additional entry assessment in the form of an interview, talent test (e.g. audition, drawing), or other similar activities.Application fees are as follows:<ul style="list-style-type: none">Php 500.00 for Filipinos studying in the PhilippinesPhp 1, 000.00 for Foreigners studying in the Philippines, andPhp 3, 000.00 LEAPMed ApplicantsDeadline of application is December 18, 2020. Your Applicant Number is found here.
