- 8.3. Tie-breaker: Re-rating of SA Coordinator and Level Coordinator
- 9. Official announcement to be done one day after the Academic Committee meeting; Contestability period of three school days after official announcement of honors / awardees by the class advisers.
- 10. Any observed disciplinary offense that has merited a Violation Report would forfeit points earned in any of the listed criteria.
